After Pisa in 1997 and Heraklion in 1998, ECDL will take place in Paris at the prestigious location of the Bibliothèque Nationale de France. It is the third of a series, partially funded by the European Commission's TMR Programme, of European conferences on research and technology for digital libraries. Its main objective is to bring together researchers from multiple disciplines to present their work on enabling technologies for digital libraries. The conference also provides an opportunity for scientists to develop a research community in Europe focusing on digital library development.

The program committee selected 26 papers from 124 submissions. Besides these, two papers were invited. One is by Jean-François Abramatic, the Chairman of the WWW Consortium, and the second by Robert Wilensky, Professor at U.C. Berkeley.
