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Preface

The Chinese Lexical Semantics Workshop (CLSW 2019) was the 20th conference in the series established in 2000. CLSW has been held in different Asian cities, including Beijing, Hong Kong, Taipei, Singapore, Xiamen, Hsin Chu, Yantai, Suzhou, Wuhan, Zhengzhou, Macao, Leshan, and Chia-Yi. In 2019, CLSW returned to Beijing, one of its founding sites, to celebrate its 20th anniversary. Over the years, CLSW has become one of the most important venues for scholars to report and discuss the latest progress in Chinese Lexical Semantics and related fields, including theoretical linguistics, applied linguistics, computational linguistics, information processing, and computational lexicography. CLSW has significantly impacted and promoted academic research and application development in the aforementioned fields, and acted as one of the most important meetings in Asia for Chinese Lexical Semantics.

CLSW 2019 was hosted by the Beijing Information Science and Technology University (BISTU), China. This year, 254 papers were submitted to the conference, setting the highest record to date. All submissions went through a double-blind review process by at least two independent reviewers. Of all the submissions, 95 (37%) were accepted as oral papers and 79 (31%) as poster papers. Among accepted papers, selected English papers are included in this Springer LNAI series. They are organized in topical sections covering all major topics of lexical semantics, semantic resources, corpus linguistics, and natural language processing.
