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Preface

The first International Symposium on Algorithms was held in Tokyo in 1990 and the second one in Taipei in 1991. The title was changed to International Symposium on Algorithms and Computation in 1992 when it was held in Nagoya. Later the symposiums were held in Hong Kong, Beijing, and Cairns in 1993, 1994, and 1995 respectively. The papers in this volume were presented at the seventh symposium in Osaka, Japan, during December 16-18, 1996. The symposium was sponsored by Osaka Electro-Communication University, The Telecommunications Advancement Foundation, and The Asahi Glass Foundation in cooperation with the Special Interest Group on Algorithms of the Information Processing Society of Japan, the Technical Group on Theoretical Foundation of Computing of the Institute of Electronics, Information and Communication Engineers of Japan, the ACM Special Interest Group on Automata and Computability Theory, and the European Association for Theoretical Computer Science.

Chandru, D. Dobkin, D.-Z. Du, H. ElGindy, M. Golin, T. Hirata, M. Golin, A.K. Lenstra, D. Kirkpatrick, W. Rytter, M. Ogihara, A. Srinivasan, and M. Sharir. Each submitted paper was reviewed by about four program committee members. Thus, the job of the program committee is quite challenging.

We wish to thank all who submitted papers for consideration and all program committee members for their excellent work. We also thank our colleagues who contributed to the success of the symposium and the sponsors for their assistance and supports.
