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Jaehyouk Choi (Member, IEEE) was born in Seoul, South Korea. He received the B.S. degree (summa cum laude) in electrical engineering from Seoul National University, Seoul, South Korea, in 2003, and the M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in electrical and computer engineering from the Georgia Institute of Technology, Atlanta, GA, USA, in 2008 and 2010, respectively.

From 2010 to 2011, he was with Qualcomm, Inc., San Diego, CA, USA, where he was involved in designing multi standard cellular transceivers. In 2012, he joined the Ulsan National Institute of Science and Technology (UNIST), Ulsan, South Korea, and served as a Faculty Member. Since 2019, he has been an Associate Professor at the Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST), Daejeon, South Korea. His research has been focused on high-performance mixed-signal and RF integrated circuits for wireless/wired communication systems and high-speed interfaces. He has authored and coauthored more than 80 journals and conference publications.

Dr. Choi has been a member of the Technical Program Committee of the IEEE International Solid-State Circuits Conference (ISSCC) since 2017, the IEEE European Solid-State Circuits Conference (ESSCIRC) since 2016, and the IEEE Asia Solid-State Circuits Conference (A-SSCC) since 2021. He served as a Distinguished Lecturer of the IEEE Solid-State Circuits Society (SSCS) in 2020 and 2021 and also served as a Guest Editor of IEEE JOURNAL OF SOLID-STATE CIRCUITS (JSSC) in 2020. He was a recipient of the IEEE/IEIE Joint Award for Young Engineer of the Year in 2020. He is now serving as the Secretary of Far-East Regional TPC for ISSCC 2023.
