Chess Puzzle Solution

Solution: Nd5, Knight to d5. After it, Black has to take the Knight with its pawn with exd5, and White can bravely move forward its pawn on the e column to e6, opening a fire line for its Bishop on d4. + Bishop to f4. Then there is no possible salvation for Black. He did kill the pawn on e6 with fxe6, but after White does Bishop to H7 he realizes it's impossible and he resigns.
