## **Call for Nominations**

The Society on Social Implications of Technology is seeking volunteers to serve on its Board of Governors. Candidates are needed for the positions of President-Elect and Members-at-Large (3). All positions require active membership in the Society. Additionally, the position of President-Elect must have been a voting member of the Board for at least one year in the previous six years.

Nominations for either position can be self-nomination or nomination by other with the awareness of the nominee. The Members-at-Large will serve for three years, 2020-2022. The President-Elect will serve for one year in 2020, then two years as President in 2021-2022, and for two years as Past-President, 2023-2024. All members on the Board of Governors meet once per month via a conference call. Additionally, the President will also be required to attend three meetings per year of the IEEE Technical Activities Board (TAB). Financial support is available for attendance at the TAB meetings.
