"Data Communication User Research in the Post Office: Part I"

In Britain the Post Office has the responsibility of ensuring effective communication. Accordingly there is ongoing research in the area of data communications. Three areas are presented:

- i) The European study on data communications
 (The Eurodata Study)
 The history of the study, the structure and the result
 of the study are presented.
- ii) The internal Post Office data communication demand forecast
