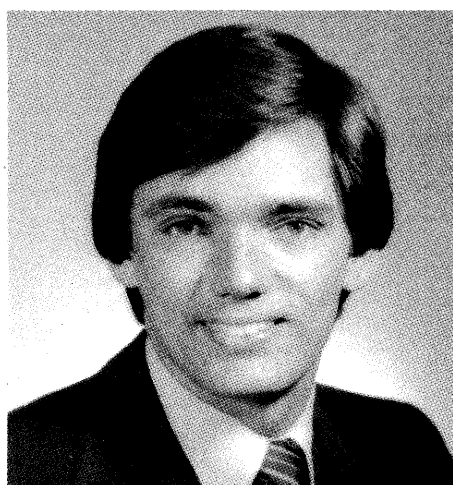


Office Automation in the Executive Suite: Successes and Strategies
