Special Section on Picture Coding and Image Media Processing

It is our great pleasure to publish this special section on Picture Coding and Image Media Processing. Since its first meeting in 1986, Picture Coding Symposium of Japan (PCSJ) has been reputed as the largest symposium on picture coding technologies in Japan. The other symposium, Image Media Processing Symposium (IMPS), was first held in conjunction with the 10th PCSJ meeting in 1996. Since then, PCSJ/IMPS have been jointly held every year and collecting a broad spectrum of academic and industrial research presentations. The special section on PCSJ/IMPS related areas started in 2007 as a letter-only section in the Japanese edition of the IEICE Transactions on Information and Systems, and then has been open to full paper submissions since 2014. The English version of the special section on the same topics started in 2017. For the English papers, on the other hand, the editorial committee finally selected 5 papers (including a letter) that offer high-quality and outstanding research results.

I would like to thank the referees and the editorial committee members for their dedicated efforts. I would also like to express my gratitude to Guest Editors, Dr. Shunsuke Iwamura of NHK, Dr. Kyohei Unno of KDDI Research, Prof. Akira Kubota of Chuo University, and Prof. Keita Takahashi of Nagoya University, for excellent organization of the entire editing process. I hope that this special section contributes to the continued success and growth of picture coding and image media processing research community.
